Apprenticeship

Level 2 Hairdressing

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Apprenticeships are increasingly recognised as the gold standard for work-based training. Already, more than 130,000 employers offer Apprenticeships.

Apprenticeships are the equivalent to 5 good GCSE passes. Apprentices work towards work-based learning qualifications such as an NVQ Level 2, Key Skills and, in some cases, a relevant knowledge-based qualification such as a BTEC. These provide the skills you need for your chosen career and allow entry to an Advanced Apprenticeship.



Introduction

The hairdressing programme is designed to give learners the essential skills and knowledge to work within a commercial salon. You will be given the opportunity to practice your techniques on members of the public as part of the course.

Course Content

The NVQ Level 2 course will take approximately 24 months to complete. You are required to attend The Creative Training Salon one day a week to practice, learn and do theory work related to the course.

The 8 mandatory units you will cover are:

- Make sure your own actions reduce risks to health and safety
- Give clients a positive impression of yourself and your organisation
- Advise and consult with clients
- Shampoo, condition and treat the hair and scalp
- Change hair colour
- Style and finish hair
- Set and dress hair
- Cut hair using basic techniques

As part of the course you will visit 'Salon International' - the biggest hair show in the country. Here you will be able to watch demonstrations and buy products and tools at a discounted rate. This is a chance for you to gain an insight into the hairdressing industry and use some of these creative ideas in your training.

Qualification

Upon completion of the programme you will receive a City & Guilds Level 2 NVQ in Hairdressing.

Assessment

Continuous assessment during the course through workplace visits, assignments and examinations to achieve set targets. Your portfolio will be checked by an internal verifier and an external verifier.

Entry Requirements

In employment in a hair salon for a minimum of 16 hours per week.

Additional Requirements

Your employer must be aware that you are required to attend 'The Creative Training Salon' one day per week. The dress code for the Training Salon is black and white.
